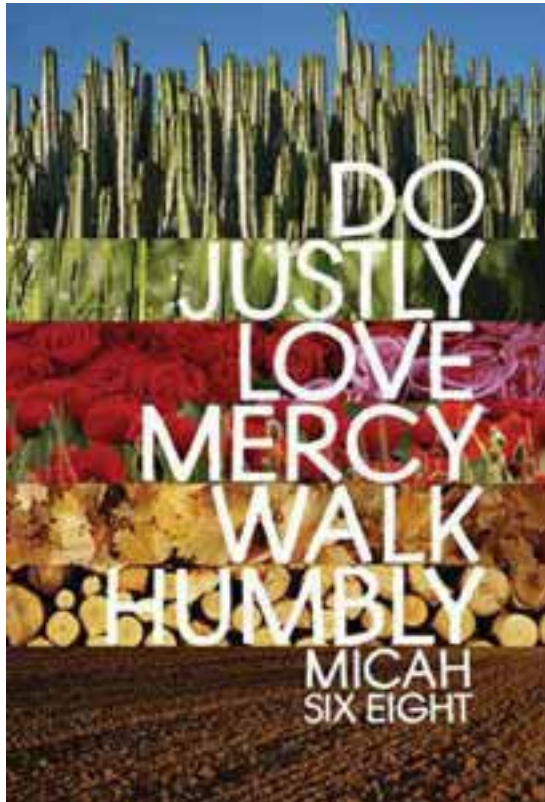

#### Pelham Road Foundation Update

The Pelham Road Baptist  
Church Foundation was  
established Oct. 20, 2010, to  
receive and manage church  
funds that are to be invested  
and the income returned to  
the church to supplement its  
programs and activities.

We envision that most gifts  
to the Foundation will be  
given through wills and trusts  
but the Foundation can also  
accept smaller regular gifts or  
one-time donations of cash  
or other property.

Bequests can include cash,  
stocks, bonds, insurance,  
jewelry or other assets.

The money put into our  
Foundation is creating  
an endowment where  
the principal is invested  
and the earnings used to  
support the ministries of  
this congregation. The  
endowment thus becomes a  
perpetual source of funding

for the work of Pelham  
Road Baptist Church. At  
this time, we are not able  
to direct income from a  
specific donation to a specific  
ministry. The Foundation  
trustees, in consultation with  
other church committees, will  
determine the best use of all  
distributed income on a year-  
by-year basis.

Three trustees oversee our  
Foundation. Those currently  
serving are Ron Rich, Darren  
Springer, and Nolen Brunson.  
The trustees are charged  
with appropriately investing  
and distributing the funds of  
the Foundation, and making  
decisions as to whether to  
accept specific proffered  
non-cash gifts.
